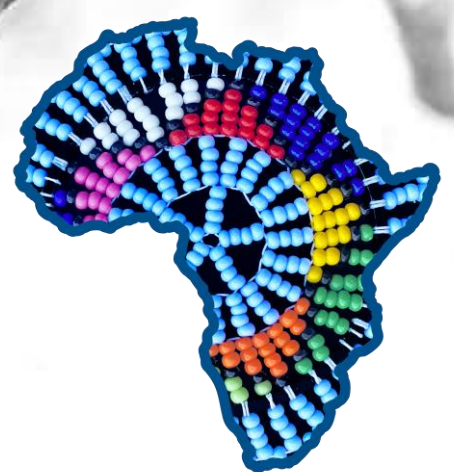

LANGUAGE

DAY 1 – SUNDAY JOHANNESBURG

On arrival in Johannesburg at OR Tambo International Airport, you'll be met by your representative and transferred to your hotel. Johannesburg is the largest and most populous city in South Africa. It is also the source of a large-scale gold and diamond trade due to its location on the mineral-rich Witwatersrand range of hills. The remainder of the day is at leisure and unescorted. Why not enjoy an optional (own account) sightseeing tour of Soweto, learning more about the struggle for freedom in South Africa, or simply relax at your hotel? At 19h00 we will meet up at reception for a briefing on the tour and a chance to meet fellow travellers.

Distance travelled today: 35 kms

DAY 2 – MONDAY JOHANNESBURG - MPUMALANGA

Depart Johannesburg after breakfast and head for Pretoria, South Africa's capital city, for a short orientation tour, before continuing to the Mpumalanga Province, known as 'Paradise Country'. Dropping several hundred feet into the lush subtropical region of the Lowveld, we travel via the historic towns of Dullstroom and Lydenburg. After traversing the famous Long Tom Pass, we travel via Sabie and arrive late afternoon into Hazyview, the safari hub of the Kruger National Park. [Breakfast]

Distance travelled today: 425 kms

DAY 3 – TUESDAY MPUMALANGA

After an early morning breakfast, we'll drive along the spectacular '**Panorama Route**', offering views of amazing scenery including the 26 kilometre-long **Blyde River Canyon** (home to the **Three Rondavels**), **Bourke's Luck Potholes** and historic **God's Window**, a breathtaking view (weather permitting) of the edge of the escarpment taking in the Kruger National Park. We arrive back in Hazyview in the late afternoon where the remainder of the day is at leisure to relax. Consider joining (for own account) a Shangaan Cultural Dinner experience, for an African dinner feast and an evening of traditional Shangaan storytelling and entertainment. [Breakfast]

Distance travelled today: 320 kms

DAY 4 – WEDNESDAY MPUMALANGA

The day begins with early morning coffee or tea, followed by a thrilling **open vehicle safari** (with English speaking game ranger) through the **Kruger National Park** with pre-packed breakfast. Kruger is one of the world's greatest national parks, home to a stunning array of wildlife. Search for the 'Big Five' (rhino, buffalo, lion, leopard, and elephant) as well as prolific birdlife and numerous other game species. The afternoon is at leisure at your hotel. An afternoon open vehicle game drive is available as an extension to the morning game drive (optional and for own account). Why not experience an exclusive el fresco bridge dinner, overlooking the magnificent Sabie River under a star-studded sky (for own account)? [Breakfast]

Distance travelled today: 120 kms

DAY 5 – THURSDAY MPUMALANGA – eSWATINI (SWAZILAND)

This morning we travel to **eSwatini** (Swaziland), an independent Kingdom within the borders of South Africa, known for its lovely scenery, crafts and colourful indigenous culture. An interactive **cultural experience and lunch** introduce us to the charming people of eSwatini (Swaziland) and their traditions. We travel via the capital city, Mbabane, to the beautiful Ezulwini Valley for overnight in eSwatini (Swaziland) with a sumptuous buffet dinner at your hotel. [Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner]

Distance travelled today: 310 kms

DAY 6 – FRIDAY eSWATINI (SWAZILAND) - ZULULAND

After breakfast we will continue south through eSwatini (Swaziland), before re-entering South Africa. Travel into Zululand, passing traditional round huts and endless vistas. There is an option to enjoy an afternoon **open vehicle safari** (optional and for own account with an English-speaking game ranger) in the **Hluhluwe-Umfolozi Game Reserve**, which contains an immense diversity of fauna and flora and is particularly famous for its conservation of black and white rhino.

Overnight in Hluhluwe-Umfolozi region. [Breakfast]

Distance travelled today: 360 kms

DAY 7 – SATURDAY ZULULAND – DURBAN (UMHLANGA)

This morning we will join a cruise on Lake St Lucia (depending on favourable weather conditions) before departing for Durban. Our journey takes us past traditional Zulu Kraals, Eucalyptus plantations and sugar cane fields. We arrive early afternoon and the remainder of the day is at leisure to enjoy the golden beaches of the Indian Ocean. Overnight in Durban (Umhlanga). [Breakfast]

Distance travelled today: 275 kms

DAY 8 – SUNDAY **DURBAN (UMHLANGA) - KNYSNA**

After breakfast, transfer to Durban (Umhlanga) airport for the short southward flight to Port Elizabeth, where we will be met by our representative and once everyone has arrived, we set off to explore the magnificent beauty of the indigenous Tsitsikamma Forest. Visit the spectacularly beautiful **Tsitsikamma National Park and Storms River Mouth** (weather permitting). We'll arrive at our hotel in **Knysna**, known as the oyster box of South Africa, nestling on the banks of a beautiful lagoon in the heart of the Garden Route. Overnight in Knysna, with dinner at JJ's Restaurant, renowned for dishes with glorious aromas and flavours, using the finest local ingredients and freshly-picked herbs from the region. [Breakfast & Dinner]

Distance travelled today: 360 kms

DAY 9 – MONDAY **KNYSNA**

After a leisurely breakfast we'll enjoy a lagoon cruise to the **Featherbed Nature Reserve** (weather permitting), where we can take a trailer ride to the top of the Western Head to enjoy panoramic views of the town and lagoon, returning for a sumptuous lunch. The afternoon is at leisure to further explore this charming town set around a natural harbour lagoon. [Breakfast & Lunch]

Distance travelled today: 15 kms

DAY 10 – TUESDAY **KNYSNA - OUDTSHOORN**

Travel through the **Outeniqua Pass** to **Oudtshoorn**, known as the 'ostrich capital' and the centre of the world's Ostrich farming industry. We'll visit an **Ostrich Farm** for a fun filled interactive tour and light lunch that includes local specialities such as Ostrich Steak, before taking a tour of the spectacular limestone caverns of the **Cango Caves**, one of the world's great natural wonders, sculpted by nature through the ages. We arrive at our hotel in the late afternoon in time to check in and relax before dinner (for own account).

Overnight in Oudtshoorn. [Breakfast & Lunch]

Distance travelled today: 210 kms

DAY 11 – WEDNESDAY **OUDTSHOORN – CAPE TOWN**

There is an option (for own account and subject to availability) to enjoy an early morning **Meerkat Safari**. Witness these incredible wild habituated creatures emerging out of their burrows in time to soak up the sun before they head about their daily activities (weather permitting). After this thrilling experience, head back for a delicious breakfast. After breakfast, the journey continues through the 'Little Karoo' to **Barrydale**, where you will have the opportunity to visit a **local farm school**, interact with the children and teachers, spending time with them in the classroom learning more about the local farming community, before travelling to Montagu, a picturesque and historic spa town. (The school visit is subject to the school being open). Continue to Cape Town, spectacularly set at the foot of Table Mountain. Overnight in Cape Town [Breakfast]

Distance travelled today: 468 kms

DAY 12 – THURSDAY **CAPE TOWN (UNESCORTED)**

Enjoy a full day at leisure. Perhaps join a sightseeing tour of Cape Town and Table Mountain (own account) or simply explore the city. Although a small city, Cape Town is packed with sightseeing attractions, excellent bars, cafés and restaurants as well as colourful craft markets. Alternatively relax on one of Cape Town's many pristine beaches. Enjoy a fun filled evening with interactive entertainment and delectable food at Gold Restaurant.

Overnight in Cape Town. [Breakfast & Dinner]

Distance travelled today: 10 kms

DAY 13 – FRIDAY **CAPE TOWN**

Enjoy a full day tour of the **Cape Peninsula**, offering some of the most spectacular coastal scenery in the world. Drive through Sea Point, the seaside village of **Hout Bay** (where you can enjoy an optional and for own account seal island boat cruise) and then on to **Cape Point** where (by tradition) it is said that the Atlantic and Indian Oceans meet. We'll return to Cape Town by way of **Simon's Town**, where we visit the **Penguin colony at Boulders Beach** (entrance fee for own account) and Fish Hoek fishing village.

Overnight in Cape Town. [Breakfast]

Distance travelled today: 200 kms

DAY 14 – SATURDAY **CAPE TOWN**

Enjoy some last-minute shopping (unescorted) or sightseeing (own account). The Robben Island Tour (for own account and time permitting) which departs from the Victoria & Alfred Waterfront, offers a fascinating excursion. Or perhaps just wander through the variety of shops and boutiques catering for all tastes and budgets? Later you will be transferred to the airport, harbour or railway station for your onward journey. [Breakfast]

If you've always dreamed of experiencing an overnight in the scenic Cape Winelands, then this option is for you. You will have the opportunity to maximise your experience of picturesque vineyards, breath-taking scenery, warm hospitality and fine wines, thereafter re-joining the tour with minimum disruption.

DAY 11 – WEDNESDAY

OUDTSHOORN - FRANSCHHOEK

Travel to Franschhoek, a picturesque village surrounded by spectacular vineyards, where French Huguenots settled more than 300 years ago, bringing with them their age-old French wine and food culture. Overnight in Franschhoek. [Breakfast]

After a leisurely breakfast, meet your tour guide and set out to the picturesque Winelands of Paarl and Stellenbosch, surrounded by awe inspiring scenery. Enjoy two wine tastings and a cellar tour before continuing to Cape Town, where you'll re-join the main tour. [Breakfast]

STANDARD CONDITIONS OF BUSINESS

1. UNDERTAKING

Blue Savannah Sky undertakes to provide all services offered subject to the terms and conditions set out herein, which terms and conditions are accepted by the passenger.

2. DEFINITION

Passenger means: Individuals, groups, companies or other legal persons using the services offered by Blue Savannah Sky and includes the agents of passengers.

Services means: The provision of accommodations and/or transportation and/or meals as offered by Blue Savannah Sky and accepted by the Passenger.

3. TERMS OF PAYMENT

3.1 On confirmation of services - a deposit of 25 % of the quoted tour price is required (N.B: For tours that include Blue Train and/or Private Game Reserves and Lodges, a different schedule of deposits, payments and cancellation fees apply. This will be provided when applicable.)

45 days before commencement of services - full payment plus rooming list is required.

Notes

- i) Bookings made within 45 days of commencement of services must be accompanied by full payment of the tour plus rooming list.
- ii) Where circumstances do not permit the timeous receipt of funds, explicit confirmation of transfer of funds will enable us to reserve services.

3.2 If payments are made in negotiable foreign currency, the payer will be responsible for any short payment resulting from exchange rate fluctuations. The exchange rate applied by the official bankers of Blue Savannah Sky on receipt of moneys will be accepted as the applicable rate.

3.3 If the required deposit or final payment is not received by due date, Blue Savannah Sky reserves the right to withdraw services.

4. CANCELLATIONS

4.1 General Conditions

4.1.1 Cancellations made more than 45 days prior to arrival will not normally result in cancellation fees being charged. However;

4.1.2 Blue Savannah Sky reserves the right to recover any costs incurred or charges received from suppliers up to the date of cancellation.

4.1.3 In the event of services being cancelled 45 days or less, prior to arrival, the following cancellation fees will apply.

- 45 days to 36 days before commencement of services: 25% total quoted tour price due. (Subject to 2. above)
- 35 days to 16 days before commencement of services: 50% of total quoted tour price due. (Subject to 2. above)
- 15 days or less before commencement of services: 100% of the total quoted tour price due

Notes

We recommend that you ensure that your passengers take adequate personal cancellation insurance cover before departure from home.

4.2 Special Conditions

For tours that include services of certain suppliers with more stringent policies, e.g., National Parks Board, Blue Train, Private Lodges and others, different cancellation fees will be enforceable. These will be provided when applicable.

5. AIRLINES

Cancellations and refunds

In the event of cancellation or failure, for any reason whatsoever, to use confirmed space, as ticketed, 25% (twenty five percent) of the applicable airfare will be forfeited. A change of reservation constitutes a cancellation. Extension of ticket validity is not permitted, save when a passenger is hospitalised due to illness or in the event of death of a member of the passenger's immediate family.

Responsibilities and booking conditions

All airfare reservations are arranged subject to the conditions imposed by the respective airline.

6. LUGGAGE

One suitcase and one overnight bag per person is allowed. Blue Savannah Sky accepts no responsibility for loss or damage to luggage or personal property from whatsoever cause arising. Passengers are advised to take up adequate insurance cover.

7. DELAYS

Blue Savannah Sky shall not be responsible for the consequences of any delays whether arising from accidents, breakdowns, or any other cause.

8. RESPONSIBILITY

Blue Savannah Sky carries comprehensive passenger liability insurance details of which will be made available on request. Blue Savannah Sky is not responsible for any damages sustained by any passenger as a result of any act or omission whatsoever of any hotel, airline or other person, notwithstanding the fact the Blue Savannah Sky acted as agent of such hotel, airline or other person.

9. LAW

The law of the Republic of South Africa shall govern the relationship between Blue Savannah Sky and the passenger and the Courts of the Republic of South Africa shall have sole jurisdiction in respect of any claims and/or disputes which may arise between Blue Savannah Sky and the passenger, or Agent.
