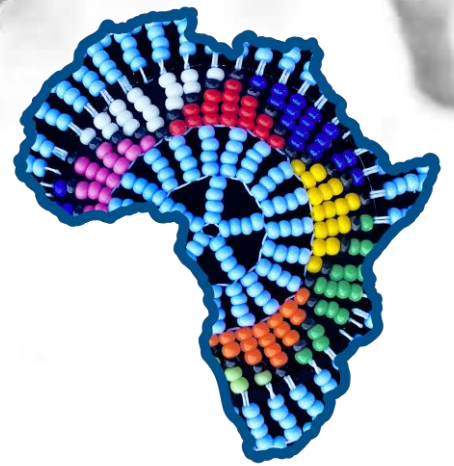




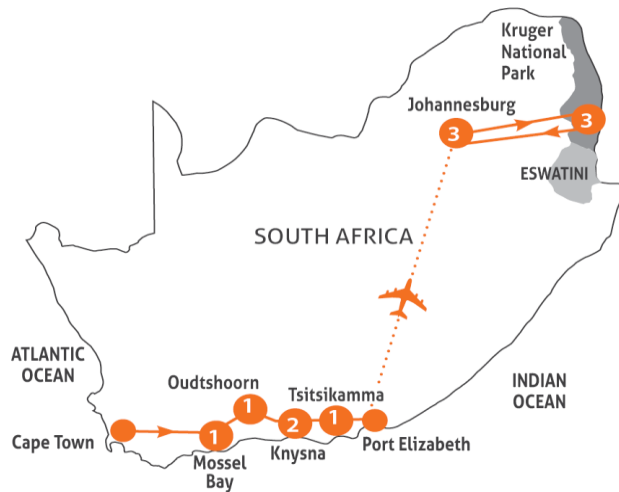

DAY 1 – MONDAY**CAPE TOWN – MOSSEL BAY**

This morning you will be met by your local tour guide and depart for the scenic Garden Route. Travel along **Sir Lowry's Pass**, with its magnificent views, to Grabouw and Elgin, a lush landscape surrounded by majestic mountains. Our journey continues to **Cape Agulhas**, the **southernmost tip of Africa**, where the Atlantic and Indian Oceans meet. The area has largely been untouched and unexplored with its rugged coastline being the graveyard for many a ship. The **historic Cape Agulhas Lighthouse** is considered the icon that signifies the tip of Africa. After this thrilling experience, we continue via historic **Swellendam**, the third oldest town in South Africa, to **Mossel Bay**, from where the Garden Route extends to the Storms River in the east. Overnight in Mossel Bay.

Distance travelled today: 507 kms

DAY 2 – TUESDAY**MOSSEL BAY - OUDTSHOORN**

After breakfast we continue our journey to **Oudtshoorn**, the ostrich capital of the world and home to the spectacular limestone caverns of the Cango Caves. Visit an **Ostrich Farm** for a guided tour. Enjoy a **wine tasting** at a local wine estate before setting off on a tour of the **Cango Caves**, one of the world's great natural wonders, sculpted by nature through the ages.

Overnight in Oudtshoorn. [Breakfast & Dinner]

Distance travelled today: 155 kms

DAY 3 – WEDNESDAY**OUDTSHOORN - KNYSNA**

After breakfast, travel over the **Outeniqua Pass** to **George**, the sixth oldest town in South Africa, with many historical landmarks like the Slave Tree and King Edward VII Library building; said to be the best example of Edwardian architecture in the town. The tour travels via **Wilderness**, an attractive holiday resort to **Knysna**, known as the oyster box of South Africa, nestling on the banks of a beautiful lagoon in the heart of the Garden Route. Enjoy a lagoon cruise to the **Featherbed Nature Reserve** (weather permitting), where you can take a trailer ride to the top of the Western Head to enjoy panoramic views of the town and lagoon, returning for lunch. The afternoon is at leisure to further explore this charming town set around a natural harbour lagoon.

Overnight in Knysna. [Breakfast & Lunch]

Distance travelled today: 134 kms

DAY 4 – THURSDAY**KNYSNA**

Today you'll have the opportunity to explore the natural beauty of the Knysna area. Your journey will include a visit to the **Garden of Eden**, set in the lush, green, indigenous Knysna forest. The major attraction is the forest itself, beautiful yellow wood trees, thick green foliage and streams. Afterwards you'll have the opportunity to visit **Monkeyland Primate Sanctuary**, where you will be able to see a variety of primates, roaming free in the forest. The sanctuary is well known for its efforts to rehabilitate and free previously caged primates. The tour continues to the famous Eastern Head, where you will enjoy spectacular views of the **Knysna Heads** (weather permitting). Afterwards you'll travel to **Brenton on Sea**, a breath-taking holiday location and a nature lover's paradise with its unspoilt beaches and peaceful surroundings. The remainder of the afternoon will be at leisure.

Overnight in Knysna. [Breakfast]

Distance travelled today: 110 kms

DAY 5 – FRIDAY**KNYSNA - TSITSIKAMMA**

Travel to **Plettenberg Bay**, the jewel of the Garden Route, before visiting **Birds of Eden sanctuary**, the biggest single free flight aviary in the world. The sanctuary was developed to create a safe environment in which to release a large collection of free-flight African birds. Our journey continues to **Bloukrans Bridge**, the highest single span arch bridge in the world, currently offering the highest commercially operated **Bungy Jump** in the world. Visit the **Tsitsikamma National Park and Storms River Mouth** (weather permitting). The Tsitsikamma National Park incorporates 80 km of rocky coastline with spectacular sea and landscapes, a remote mountainous region with secluded valleys covered in mountain Fynbos and temperate high forests with deep river gorges leading down to the sea.

Overnight in the Tsitsikamma area. [Breakfast]

Distance travelled today: 100 kms

DAY 6 – SATURDAY**TSITSIKAMMA – PORT ELIZABETH - JOHANNESBURG**

Head eastwards along the Tsitsikamma Forest to Port Elizabeth, known as the "friendly city" with a wonderful climate. Travel to Port Elizabeth Airport for an onward flight to Johannesburg, where you'll be met and transferred to your hotel. The remainder of the day is yours to relax (unescorted).

Overnight in Johannesburg. [Breakfast]

Distance travelled today: 185 kms

DAY 7 – SUNDAY JOHANNESBURG

Spend a full day exploring **Soweto** and surrounds. The tour starts with a visit to the prestigious **Apartheid Museum**, located in Johannesburg's Ormondo suburb. The museum covers the full history of the Apartheid era in South Africa. From here you will continue to Soweto for a tour through this vibrant township. You will visit the **Hector Peterson Memorial** that commemorates the role of the country's students in the struggle against Apartheid. Continue to the **Liliesleaf Heritage Site** for a tour. Once known as Liliesleaf Farm this fascinating heritage site is closely linked to the Rivonia Treason Trial that led to Nelson Mandela's incarceration. In the early 1960's Liliesleaf was a sanctuary where most prominent leaders of South Africa's struggle against Apartheid sought shelter, attended secret meetings and engaged in key debates on political and military policy and strategy. You will learn in detail what happened during those days and the ultimate arrest of Nelson Mandela.

Return to your hotel for overnight. [Breakfast]

Distance travelled today: 100 kms

DAY 8 – MONDAY JOHANNESBURG

Enjoy a **full day at leisure** and unescorted. Perhaps join a tour to Maropeng, the Cradle of Mankind (optional and for own account) or enjoy some shopping at Nelson Mandela Square, home to a variety of shops and boutiques catering for all tastes and budgets.

Overnight in Johannesburg. [Breakfast]

DAY 9 – TUESDAY JOHANNESBURG - KRUGER NATIONAL PARK

This morning you will be collected from your hotel, heading east to the Mpumalanga region. After freshening up at your lodge enter the world-famous **Kruger National Park** and spend the afternoon **game viewing** in your closed touring vehicle. The park offers some of the best game viewing and wildlife opportunities in the world – and you'll soon appreciate the challenges of managing this unique reserve. After an action-packed afternoon in the Kruger Park, enjoy authentic cuisine from the region, around a cosy campfire at your lodge. [Breakfast & Dinner]

Distance travelled today: 430 kms

DAY 10 – WEDNESDAY KRUGER NATIONAL PARK

The day begins with early morning coffee or tea, followed by a thrilling **open vehicle game drive** (with English speaking game ranger) through **Kruger National Park** with pre-packed breakfast. Your guide will endeavour to spoil you with sightings of the 'Big Five', general game and prolific bird life. Return to the lodge for lunch (own account) and a short siesta. In the afternoon we will journey once again through the magnificent expanses of the Kruger National Park, unrivalled in its diversity of flora and fauna. Enjoy an afternoon of game viewing in your closed touring vehicle pursuing the Big Five and other rare and endangered species. Optional (own account) open vehicle game drives are available. Return to the lodge for a dinner of African specialities, served outdoors by the light of a campfire. [Breakfast & Dinner]

Distance travelled today: 250 kms

DAY 11 – THURSDAY MPUMALANGA

Enjoy breakfast before setting out to explore the magnificent **Panorama Route**, one of the most scenic routes in the region, offering glorious views, spectacular landscapes and exquisite waterfalls. Visit majestic sights including **God's Window**, the **Three Rondavels** and **Blyde River Canyon** – the third largest canyon of its kind in the world, **Bourke's Luck Potholes** and the charming village of **Graskop**, one of the first gold mining camps in the country. Optional (own account) open vehicle game drives are available, should you prefer not to join the Panorama Route tour.

Return to your lodge for a delectable buffet Boma Dinner, served under the light of the stars. [Breakfast & Dinner]

Distance travelled today: 260 kms

DAY 12 – FRIDAY MPUMALANGA – JOHANNESBURG

Enjoy breakfast before starting the return journey to Johannesburg. Arrive in Johannesburg, at OR Tambo International Airport, at approximately 14h30, where the tour ends on arrival. [Breakfast]

Distance travelled today: 400 kms

STANDARD CONDITIONS OF BUSINESS

1. UNDERTAKING

Blue Savannah Sky undertakes to provide all services offered subject to the terms and conditions set out herein, which terms and conditions are accepted by the passenger.

2. DEFINITION

Passenger means: Individuals, groups, companies or other legal persons using the services offered by Blue Savannah Sky and includes the agents of passengers.

Services means: The provision of accommodations and/or transportation and/or meals as offered by Blue Savannah Sky and accepted by the Passenger.

3. TERMS OF PAYMENT

3.1 On confirmation of services - a deposit of 25 % of the quoted tour price is required (N.B: For tours that include Blue Train and/or Private Game Reserves and Lodges, a different schedule of deposits, payments and cancellation fees apply. This will be provided when applicable.)

45 days before commencement of services - full payment plus rooming list is required.

Notes

- i) Bookings made within 45 days of commencement of services must be accompanied by full payment of the tour plus rooming list.
- ii) Where circumstances do not permit the timeous receipt of funds, explicit confirmation of transfer of funds will enable us to reserve services.

3.2 If payments are made in negotiable foreign currency, the payer will be responsible for any short payment resulting from exchange rate fluctuations. The exchange rate applied by the official bankers of Blue Savannah Sky on receipt of moneys will be accepted as the applicable rate.

3.3 If the required deposit or final payment is not received by due date, Blue Savannah Sky reserves the right to withdraw services.

4. CANCELLATIONS

4.1 General Conditions

4.1.1 Cancellations made more than 45 days prior to arrival will not normally result in cancellation fees being charged. However;

4.1.2 Blue Savannah Sky reserves the right to recover any costs incurred or charges received from suppliers up to the date of cancellation.

4.1.3 In the event of services being cancelled 45 days or less, prior to arrival, the following cancellation fees will apply.

- 45 days to 36 days before commencement of services: 25% total quoted tour price due. (Subject to 2. above)
- 35 days to 16 days before commencement of services: 50% of total quoted tour price due. (Subject to 2. above)
- 15 days or less before commencement of services: 100% of the total quoted tour price due

Notes

We recommend that you ensure that your passengers take adequate personal cancellation insurance cover before departure from home.

4.2 Special Conditions

For tours that include services of certain suppliers with more stringent policies, e.g., National Parks Board, Blue Train, Private Lodges and others, different cancellation fees will be enforceable. These will be provided when applicable.

5. AIRLINES

Cancellations and refunds

In the event of cancellation or failure, for any reason whatsoever, to use confirmed space, as ticketed, 25% (twenty five percent) of the applicable airfare will be forfeited. A change of reservation constitutes a cancellation. Extension of ticket validity is not permitted, save when a passenger is hospitalised due to illness or in the event of death of a member of the passenger's immediate family.

Responsibilities and booking conditions

All airfare reservations are arranged subject to the conditions imposed by the respective airline.

6. LUGGAGE

One suitcase and one overnight bag per person is allowed. Blue Savannah Sky accepts no responsibility for loss or damage to luggage or personal property from whatsoever cause arising. Passengers are advised to take up adequate insurance cover.

7. DELAYS

Blue Savannah Sky shall not be responsible for the consequences of any delays whether arising from accidents, breakdowns, or any other cause.

8. RESPONSIBILITY

Blue Savannah Sky carries comprehensive passenger liability insurance details of which will be made available on request. Blue Savannah Sky is not responsible for any damages sustained by any passenger as a result of any act or omission whatsoever of any hotel, airline or other person, notwithstanding the fact the Blue Savannah Sky acted as agent of such hotel, airline or other person.

9. LAW

The law of the Republic of South Africa shall govern the relationship between Blue Savannah Sky and the passenger and the Courts of the Republic of South Africa shall have sole jurisdiction in respect of any claims and/or disputes which may arise between Blue Savannah Sky and the passenger, or Agent.
